For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He has no form, no majesty and when we see Him; there is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected of men; a Man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering and like one from who man hide their faces, He was despised, and we put Him out for nothing.

Surely He has borne our infirmities (sickness of body or soul or spirit), and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

But He was wounded for our transgressions; He was crushed for our iniquities: the punishment of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed. →

We also made a trip to the Dead Sea. It was extremely hot weather, but it was little windy and also some clouds, so it was "good weather", anyway. The Dead Sea has no outpouring river, just an inflowing the Jordan River. That's why it becomes so salty and dead. (The likeness: We must give out our faith to others, we can't keep it for ourselves, otherwise, we become dead Christians. Read the word of Jesus; **And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, all power is given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go you therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit: Teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you: and see, I am with you always, even to the end of the world. Amen. *Matthew 28:18-20* *Read the word of Paul; faith + LOVE= very good 1 Cor. 12-14*) It was also extremely dangerous to bath; they had a guard checking up all those who were bathing. I got some salt in my eye and thought; "now I must visit the doctor", but I took a shower with fresh water and the eye was ok; but if someone gets much water in the lungs he can get serious problems, I think. It was also some kind of quicksand, very dangerous, on the sides of the sea. So with clear words the Dead Sea is a very dangerous place and it is also the lowest place on earth on dry land, 418 meter below sea level. The Dead Sea is a sign for everyone in the whole world that homosexuality is one of the lowest sins that human beings can live in. If you check up in the history books you can see that before a country or civilization really is going down in a catastrophe, there is homosexuality in the end, just as it was in Sodom and Gomorrah; those towns were located at the Dead Sea area. **And the LORD said, because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grave (very bad).****

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My wife, me and our youngest son, 15 years old, traveled to the holy land, Israel, this summer (2009). We stayed 13 days in the old town of Jerusalem, near the Jaffa gate. It was very good, near all the holy places.

In my youth I met a man, not “so Christian”, but he said something like this: “Jerusalem is the most “electrical, special” town in the whole world!” This man had been traveling a lot, in many countries.

In Israel it was easy to talk with nice people— Jews, Arabs, Armenians and tourists, especially a very nice man from Russia. Russians really like to go to Israel and many tourists from Russia are going there. There are “many” Russian Orthodox Churches in Jerusalem. We visited one of them, The Church of Mary Magdalene. It’s a VERY BEAUTIFUL Church and so peaceful and calm inside. There are some Russian souvenir shops and many tourist books are also in the Russian language. After a long day of travel we came to Gordon’s Golgotha, also called the Garden Tomb, a really resting place with the tomb that Charles Gordon found 1883. If it is the right place of the Tomb of Jesus or not, doesn’t care so much, the main thing is the peace of Jesus that comes when we think of His death, that He died for us, for our sins. This Garden has many plants and humble people taking care of the place. It is really a place of peace with many trees and plants and places to sit and relax. Here I got a really touch of the peace of Jesus. We also visited the Church of the Holy Sepulcher which also can be the right place of the Tomb of Jesus.

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you: not as the world gives, give I to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid, says Jesus in *John 14:27*

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But before they lay down, the men of the city, the men of Sodom, surrounded the house, both old and young, all the people from every quarter: and they called Lot, where are the men that came in to you this night, bring them out so we may know them (carnally). *1 Genesis 19:4*

The sun was raised upon the earth when Lot entered into Soar. Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven; and He destroyed those cities, and all the plain, and all the inhabitants of the cities, and that which grew on the ground. But his wife looked back and she became a pillar of salt.

1 Genesis 19:23-26

Then back to Jerusalem again; there are many holy places and I think one place is really in the heart of God Himself- The Church of Mary Magdalene, one of the most visible churches in Jerusalem, on the side of The Mount of Olives. The woman, Mary of Magdalene, had been a sinful woman of whom Jesus had driven out seven demons, but now she was a good woman. This church put up the truth that for Jesus there is no hopeless people, everyone can be saved if he or she turn to Jesus- prostitutes, homosexuals, murderers, thieves and so on. Yes, there is salvation in the blood of Jesus, as the Bible says:

But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. *1 John 1:7-10* →

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We all like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. Because of the suffering of His soul, He shall see much fruit and be well satisfied. By His knowledge shall my righteous Servant justify many; for He shall bear their sins (iniquity). Therefore will I divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the great multitudes, because He has poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the transgressors; and He bares the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Jerusalem has been a place where holy things have been taken place, for a very long time; maybe before Melchizedek he blessed Abraham around the year 2090 before Christ. Jerusalem is also the place where Jesus the Son of God will come down from Heaven and rule over the whole world, as we Christians believe

Here I could see it very clearly. I really recommend a visit here! Then the second thing: One of the most outstanding things in Israel- THE DEAD SEA SCROLLS. I believe it is a Birthday present to the State of Israel from God Himself, that their faith is true and that the Old Testament is truly the word of God. Why did they not find them 50 or 150 years before 1948? **This is really the finger of God! →**

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
