A story to help people in need

Many people like to be like “him”, but they fail,
because they don't have the big book– the Bible,
and what it says about all sins in our lives.
Read *Matthew 5:6* and *Psalms 119:160*

The day “he” understood that without his Master
and Lord Jesus Christ, he could do nothing.
Read *John 15:5*. And he must also take one day at
a time. Read *Matthew 6:33-34*. That was the day
he got the name “MERCY ABOVE MERCY”.

When I got saved and born again 1980, I asked a
man
in my church: “Can any who use alcohol continues to
drink, and then pray for forgiveness?”
He answered for a while: “It can work, but not in the
long run, and then it is difficult.” After this answer it
became clear; when Jesus shows that something is a
sin, I must fight to get rid of it, whatever it is, and
honestly pray to God for help. So, during our earthly
walk, Jesus shows different sins we have and we
must confess them. It's good to tell someone about
my sins and pray to God for help. Read *James 5:13-
20* and the whole New Testament.

Jesus will help us when we honestly pray to Him!

In one way or another he doesn't look to live himself
but he has someone's stronger life inside himself-
“Christ in you, our glories hope.” *Colossians 1:27*
The word “Peace thru the blood of Jesus” is always
on his tongue. However he knows to be aware of
some places: “LAZY INN”- a beautiful hotel on the
outside, but inside people do the most dirty,
disgusting things.

“**The lazy man is full of desires.**” *Proverbs 13:4*
Don't be lazy! You will get problems for sure! Even
if you growing up there at “LAZY INN” you can get
out with help of Jesus, *Gospel of John 15:5, Ps.51.*

“**With God everything is possible**”, *Mark 10:27*
“OTHER WOMEN'S UNHOLY PLACES”: **No one
that goes in to her, turns around and again finds
the way of life**, *Proverbs 2:19*, read also *Matthew 5:
27-32*. (Jesus judges those who don't know the way
much *softer* than those who *really know* the way and
the Lord. Read the parable of the lost son, *Luke 15:
11-32, Luke 12:47-49* and *Hebrew 10:26-31*).

Many lie about this sin, but with their conscience
they know it is a big sin and even their children and
animals know, because they feel very bad about it.
“THE CASTLE OF WRATH”: Many are stuck there in
the chamber, *Matthew 5:20-26*. Many think they are
“Strong” people because they get angry, but they are
in great trouble, read also *Matthew 12:33-37*

When I gave my life to God, 18 years old, I got a joy that was outstanding, accepted by God and Jesus it was so peaceful. The story is about a figurative person - "Mercy above mercy." He can fall little sometimes, *Proverbs 24:16* but he is like the man in the box, no matter how much you put him down, he is coming up anyway. Or like an old boxing partner, no matter how much you knock him down, he is coming up anyway.

Yes, "Mercy above mercy" is an "impossible" fighter, a more stable

partner you cannot have with you during the way to Heaven. Yes he looks to be little outside the ordinary rules, because he always stands up and walk on fearless against new enemies and new goals.

"THE LYING LAKE": It's impossible to swim there. Many think that lake doesn't exist, and many think they are not there, but they are really there. Many are also washing themselves in the lake, and they are also washing things they have and things they done.

If you have too much contact with that lake the devil can be your father forever, read *John 8:44*.

"COSY CABIN OF FEARFULLNESS": Read

Revelation 21:8. Many, so called strong and tough people are there, but of course they think they are not there- Jesus is the only one to really look up to.

"THE MOUNTAIN OF SELFISHNESS AND PRIDE":

Read *Ephesians 5:5, Ezekiel 28:11-19 and Proverbs 16:18*. In distance that mountain can look good, but if you get near you see that the top of the mountain is bending over. Everyone on that trip will hopelessly die. Even some old people are there climbing. My old sister in the Lord, 94 years old said: "We are dust, never forget it!"

His friendship is of great value for people, during the way to Heaven. Just once I have heard of him being in big trouble, when he was lost in "THE JUNGLE OF FREEDOM FROM CONDEMNATION", read *Matthew 5-7 especially 5:17 and Romans chapter 1-8 especially 8:1-* which many Christians misuse.
