•No matter how bad you are; Jesus is really the savior and God the Father has made the decision that we all must turn to Jesus to be a good person.

And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. *John 8:32*

Read *John 3*.

We are all sinners, so we all need Jesus- that’s the way it is, that is the basic humility for all people to except, we have no choice. THE FOUR ABSOLUTES

In old time revival in Sweden they taught this and it is very good. Many times I have been thinking of this in ordinary life. The 4 absolutes are:

Absolute truth

Absolute cleanness, holiness

Absolute love

Absolute humility

Absolute truth:

To become a Christian we must come to the truth about ourselves more or less, basically that I am a sinner, walking my own way. If we do that we stop the lies we all have. Lies protect our sins. In this subject we can go on really deep in ourselves, how we live, then we get more of Jesus glory in our lives. *John* the apostle really knew about this, read his *1 letter* – we shall live in the truth he mentions many times, read also *John 8*.

Absolute cleanness, holiness:

Jesus and the whole Bible really wants us to be holy in this business with women; look right, think right, have a clean heart. Read *Mathew 5:27-32*, *Job 31*, *1Thess 4:1-8* and *Psalm 51*. Let us all pray to be like Jesus and say like Paul; “Now I don’t live anymore, Christ is living within me.” We shall also be clean in our motives when we do good things, not eager for money or something else.
