Manna grain - We all need it

In old time in Sweden they had Manna grain on the table. It was small paper pieces with either just the "Bible place" or you must check up the Bible place in the Bible by yourself, or both the Bible place and the Bible verse on the small piece of paper.

■ **Pray always. 1 Thessalonians 5:17.** It is the smallest verse in the Swedish Bible, just two words, but so important.

How do we get motivated to pray always? Reading the Bible clearly and see how important it is that we live right and also our children and other people around us; otherwise we all get a bad life. And we can all end up in Hell, so we have a lot to pray for.

The gospel of John 13:34

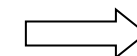

We all may have very good Christmas memories, this one was before I was born, but if I had a time machine I would like to go back in time and see this:

It was Christmas the first time, at the First World War, the year 1914. Somewhere near the border of Northern France and Belgium, The British on one side and the Germans on the other side, they had parapets on both sides from where they shooting at each other.

On Christmas Eve in the evening, the Germans began to put up Chinese lanterns and Christmas trees in and on the parapets. The British thought it was some fighting stuff so they began to shout, but no answer came so they cooled down.

Then some on the German side, began to walk unarmed into the “no mans land” and the British also send some unarmed man into the middle “no mans land.”

And on the Christmas day they continue in big scale to meet each other in “no mans land”, both soldiers and officers met each other.

They gave each other some gifts, food and other things and they also played a football match. They got really friendly and the “Small” officers made up that, “we continue this friendly Christmas act until morning on the boxing day.”

(second Christmas day in Sweden).
