## FREEDOM FROM CONDEMNATION THE FALSE WAY

This is what I call this teaching, or false spirit, that really is among Christians now in the end time. It's a horrible teaching/spirit, which in some cases leads us Christians to both deep sins and criminal deeds. This false teaching has been around since the devil tempted Eve. In the whole Old Testament as well as in the New Testament, there are many Bible scriptures that warn us concerning this. This kind of teaching is today, 2014, in all churches in Sweden, more or less, otherwise we would have revival! Basically, this false teaching/spirit concentrates on these topics: happy promises, salvation through faith, and we don't have to strive to live holy pretty much. I got this teaching in the 1980's through a cassette box with four cassettes that were named "Freedom from condemnation". Through that cassette series I got that spirit strongly and it was very bad. 4-5 years later I throw the cassettes away and also many books with the same teaching/spirit, then I went for real Bible teachings and much from old revivals like; Charles Finney, Frank Mangs, etc. Sins in the end time:

In the end of the western Christianity, many churches have <u>law deeds</u>; they do the Holy Communion and at the same time many of them are pedophiles and rape children. Some of them pray for the sick, but then they want money from them, some are talking in tongues, but then they are evil against people who really need love. Many leaders like to be called teacher, master and father, but Jesus said we shall not do so. The same happened in the end of Israel 2000 years ago, the Pharisees lived with law deeds and that didn't save people. To live with law deeds is very simple - just do some good deeds and then don't care of other good deeds. Jesus wants us to change what's wrong in our lives and He will help us if we confess our sins and lack of love that we all have. For example Judas was a pretty good man, but he sometimes stole money. We must stop to sin, even if it's little, otherwise we miss Heaven.

This is what **William Booth**, the founder of Salvation Army, said would happen in the end time;

- Religion without the Holy Spirit Christianity without Christ (it is very common in the western world) Forgiveness without Repentance (keep on sinning, just do the holy communion now and then) Salvation without Regeneration (be born again, get a new life, be a new creation)
- Politics without God Heaven without Hell.

Let us not live with law deeds; if we do well in 19 of 20 good deeds we are hypocrites, says Jesus in **Matthew 23.** Read carefully the whole chapter. Both Jesus and James teach the same, read also James 2:1-26: For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumbles in one point, he is guilty of all - James 2:10. Jesus says; Woe unto you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, hypocrites! Follow Jesus - not false Christians!

The same attitude Paul the Apostle had;

Not as though I had already got it, either was already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may take hold of that for which Jesus Christ took hold of me. Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. Philippians 3:12-14. We Christians can't be too sure that we will be in Heaven; we must be alert as long as we live on earth, as also Jesus mentioned clearly; Be you faithful unto death, and I will give you a crown of life. Revelation 2:10

Around 1984-85 I got contact with so called spiritual people "prosperity preachers". Some of it was good, but I felt no real love of Jesus that I first felt in my old Pentecostal Church.

I got a cassette "box" that really took the humble touch of Jesus away from me. The name of the cassette "box" was "Freedom from condemnation" - but it was the false way. The teaching took away my conscience towards what was wrong/sin in a horrible way. In my mind I could have done mostly anything bad and then directly go back to Jesus without bad conscience. Jesus says; Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are very hungry wolves. You shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? Every good tree brings forth good fruit; but a corrupt (bad) tree brings forth evil fruit. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit; neither can a corrupt (bad) tree bring forth good fruit. Every tree that brings not forth good fruit is cut (saw) down, and cast into the fire. Therefore by their fruits you shall know them. Not everyone that say to Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the Kingdom of Heaven; but he that does the will of my Father which is in Heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name? And in Your name have cast out demons? And in Your name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess to them, I never knew you: depart from Me, you that work iniquity (sin). Matthew 7:15-23.

Some "Christians" will go to Hell!

I got saved in 1980 with a really joy in my heart, and I understood that I had to turn from all sins if I wanted to continue to walk with Jesus and come to Heaven. I also knew that Jesus would help me, even if I stumbled sometimes when it was hard to choose between good and bad (the Christian life is a process, and we get better and better when Jesus helps us).

I really understood that people lose their love with that teaching, a really dangerous teaching. This teaching is common among Christians today, 2014, mostly the entire western world Christianity have it, more or less. False leaders are really around, as Jesus said clearly about the end time;

Then if any man shall say to you, behold here is Christ, or there; believe it not. For there shall arise false Christ's, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect (Christians). Matthew 24:23-24.

We have to watch out clearly! We need to have a personal relation with Jesus and the whole Bible!

The false message in many churches today is; "If we just believe in Jesus, then we are really saved, we don't need to be holy or full of love, just believe in Jesus and join us." These churches can honor Jesus in a deep way, but they don't teach that we must give love and live holy, as Jesus said. For example: Have you taken the Holy Communion- you are rid of all your sins - no matter if you sin again and have a hard heart. Of course, if you are sincere in your heart, Jesus will for sure forgive and forget all your sins, over and over again. Jesus is really humble and full of love; He takes in anyone who has a honest heart. This tract is mostly about pretty strong people, who don't like to live a holy life and be full of love, as Jesus and the Bible teach us.

This with law deeds is very easy to understand, if you are earnest about yourself. Otherwise you are lying towards yourself and God, listen to this: Law deeds in the whole New Testament is about the unwillingness to follow Jesus totally. We can't just do some good deeds that are easy to do, we have to do things that are self-sacrificing and that Jesus and the Bible tells me to do.

## For example:

- Some Christian Priests go in to a room and do pedophile acts with children and then they go in to another room and do the Holy Communion and think they are with Jesus very much.
- Christians talk much about Jesus and then they seek contact with other man's/woman's partner.
- Some pray the whole night to Jesus and then at day time goes out looking at women/men or watch TV or on the internet for same reason.
- Some pray for the sick, but afterwards want people to give much money to their ministry.
- Some are very nice to some people but very bad to other people that need love.

We have to see to ourselves in the view of Jesus and the whole Bible, and then we can be ready for Heaven. Read carefully the whole New Testament, then the Old Testament, begin with Proverbs.

If you got trouble with this, contact some Christians you believe can tell you the whole truth. It's a lack of space to tell everything in this subject. My goal is that you who read this shall really get a personal relation with Jesus and the whole Bible, in a true way - without any fault, sin.

- Let me explain: If you are really sorry for your sins, then Jesus really forgives you and he will help you out of your sins, no matter how bad your sins are. In many cases, it's good to have some good Christian persons to talk to.
- If you are a "strong" person, but you have sins in your life that you don't want to get rid of, and if you still want to be a Christian, you must know that your sins are between you and Jesus, no matter how much communion you do or other good works for Jesus you have "Freedom from condemnation the false way"! Continue to read the Bible and pray earnestly to Jesus that He shows you what kind of sins you have in your life and then a way out. He will for sure help you all the way to Heaven.

## Read 1 letter of John chapter 1 and 2.

Read clearly **Deuteronomy chapter 13**, and you will see how we all get tested, if we love people more than God, Jesus and the Bible. It is also very important to read **the whole Bible by yourself.**
