

Set food and water before them that they may eat and drink and go to their master."THEN HE PREPARED A GREAT FEAST FOR THEM, and they ate and drank, he sent them away and they went to their master. LET US HAVE TRUCE THIS CHRISTMAS

Truce = resting time from weapons
Parapet = a "ditch" were soldiers hide when they shoot.

This took place especially in Saint-Yvon (Yves), region of Ypres, Belgium. Some sources say that about 100 000 Brittish, Germans and French soldiers were involved in this "unlegal" Christmas truce in different places. (You can read yourself on the web - search for "christmas truce". Also books are written in this subject.)

It was the first Christmas in the First World War 1914. The British and the French on one side, and the Germans on the other side. They had parapets on both sides from where they shot at each other. On Christmas Eve, the Germans began to put up Chinese lanterns and Christmas trees in the parapets. The British thought it was some fighting stuff, so they began to shoot, but no answer came so they cooled down. Some on the German side began to walk unarmed into the "no-man's-land", the British also sent some unarmed men to the middle of "no-man's-land". And on the Christmas day very many unarmed soldiers and even unarmed officers met each other in "no man's land" (it all happened in full daylight, and that is very remarkable in war).

Not even in the Old Testament God was out to kill in His heart, but He allows war when the sin reigns too much. He also wants us to forgive and be a people full of love. So let us always have Christmas (JESUS) in our lives. "A new command I give you: Love one another." says Jesus in the Gospel of John 13:34.

In Sweden we have a very good similar memory. In 1905 Norway was in union with Sweden. The king of Sweden reigned over Norway, but the Norwegians didn't like it, so they prepared for war, to be an independent country. Sweden also prepared for war. But the King Oscar the second had a very good wife – Sofia. She began to be a real Christian in her heart and she read the Gospel of Jesus Christ very much. She pushed her husband to make a promise:

"Promise me to not go to war with your brother Norway". At last the King made the promise:

"I promise to not go to war with my brother Norway". Of course, this is not official, but an high military that lived at that time "leaked it out". A trustworthy man of God in Norway told us about it. In my opinion, this is a pretty relevant message. How else can we be permitted to have a cross in our flag? Good Christian things have for sure happened in Sweden in the past, but unfortunately we now begin to leave Jesus. Very sad.
