• UNMERCIFUL, MERCILESS, NO COMPASSION, NO PITY (ANELEEMON): No feelings and thoughts for other people's problems. *Romans* 1:31, (Job 31, Matt. 18, Luke 10:25–42) • (Evil) LUSTS, EVIL DESIRES (EPITHYMIA): Have lust in my mind to someone else's woman/man or anything else that is not mine. *Colossians* 3:5, (Mark 4:19, Luke 22:15, John 8:44, 1 Peter 4:3, Titus 3:3, and Eph.4:17-19, Eph. 4:22. There are also good lusts: Phil. 1:23 and 1 Thess. 2:17

• LAWLESS, WITHOUT LAW (ANOMOS): Maybe the strongest word for all sins - I don't need any rules. 2 Pet. 2:8, 1 Tim.1:9, 2 Thess. 2:8, Act.2:23

1 Cor. 9:21, Luke 22:37, Mark 15:28. Rulers/Regents go against Jesus and the whole Bible - Psalm 2

• **UNRULY, REBELLIOUS, (ANYPOTAKTOS):** Not humbled or obedient. To not be under God's will, instead go for my own will. *1 Tim. 1:9, Titus1:6*

• UNGODLY (ASEBES): Not have fear of God in my acts, "I can do whatever I want" attitude. *Rom 4:5, 5:6, 2 Peter 2:5, 3:7, 1 Peter 4:18, 1 Timothy1:9, Jude 4, 15.*

• SINFUL, SINNER (HAMARTOLOS): A person that commits sins. 1 Tim. 1:9, Matt. 9:10, Jude 15, Luke 5:8, Mark 8:38 6

We have a free will/choice to have faith in Jesus. *Rev. 21:8 Mark 9:24.* God is really merciful in Jesus Christ. *Mark 6:1-6.* Let us have faith.

• DRUNKENNESS (OINOPHLYGIA): Consuming too much alcohol. Luke 21:34, Galatians 5:21, Romans 13:13

• PARTIES, REVELLINGS, ORGY (KOMOS): Sin acts with other people. *Rom. 13:13, Gal.5:21, 1 Pet. 4:3*

• DETESTABLE IDOLATRY (ATHEMITOS IDOLATRIES) Doing disgusting things, acting with really bad sense, 1 Peter 4:3. Evil desires and greed is idolatry; Colossians 3:5

• UNCLEANESS, IMPURITY (AKATHARSIA): Any kind of sinful things that people continually cling to more or less. *Matthew* 23:27, *Rom.* 1:24, 6:19, *Eph.* 4:19, 5:3, *Gal.* 5:19, *Col.* 3:5, 2 *Cor.* 12:21, 1 *Thess.* 2:3, 4:7.

• THE LOVE OF MONEY (PHILARGYRIA): Leads to many evil things. 1 Timothy 6:10, 2 Tim. 3:2

• VILE, ABOMINABLE, WICKED (EBDELYGMENOIS): Really bad acts in different sins; pedophile, adultery without shame, homosexuality and all kind of greedy desires without any shame mostly. *Rev. 21:8, Mark 13:14, Matt. 24:15, Luke 16:15, Daniel 11:31* 3

THE LAW SHALL GO OUT FROM ZION THE WORD OF THE LORD FROM JERUSALEM... MICAH 4:2

The first time it was up to date was when Melkisedek reigned at the time of Abraham (about 2091 BC; Before Christ), and then when the people of Israel got Jerusalem as their Capital City at the time of David (about 1010 BC; Before Christ), and at the time of Pentecost (about 30 AD; After Christ) when the Holy Spirit filled the Apostles of Jesus Christ and the Word of the Lord began to spread all over the world. It came to us in Sweden about 830 AD; After Christ. • ADULTERY, (MOICHEIA): Take another husband's wife or take another wife's husband - one of the most destroying sins. Jesus says also "looking with lust is adultery". *Matt.* 5:27-33, *Mark* 7:21-23, *Eph.* 5:3-33, *Prov.* 4-7, *Heb.*13:4, 1 *Tim.* 5-6.

• SEXUAL IMMORALITY (PORNEIA): All kind of sexual acts, except in a marriage between a man and a woman.

Mark 7:21, Matt.15:19-20, Eph. 5:3-33, 1 Thess. 4, Rev.21-22 2

• OCCULT MAN OR WOMAN (PHARMAKEUS): Someone who tries to change things in an occult, demonic way; with or without narcotic drugs. *Rev. 21:8, 22:15.* WITCHCRAFT (pharmakeia); uses drugs for demonic acts. *Gal. 5:20.*

• **IDOLATERS (EDOLOLATRES):** Worship and serve created things instead of the Creator. *Rom. 1:25, Rev. 21:8, Gal.5:20, 1 Pet. 4:3, 1 Cor. 5:10, 10:14.* Evil desires and greed is really idolatry also, read *Colossians 3:5.*

• DOGS (KYON): Dogs in the Bible go for bad things, also return to bad things; hunting weaker animals, eating dead things. *Rev. 22:15, Isaiah 13:22, 56:10, Psalm 22:16, 56:6, 2 Peter 2:22*

• MALICE (KAKIA): To be evil minded towards people. Wish people to have a bad life. *Rom.* 1:29, 1 *Pet.* 2:1, 16, *Matt.* 6:34, *James* 1:21, *Col.* 3:8, *Acts* 8:22, 1 *Cor.* 5:8, 14:20.

• ENVY, JEALOUSY (PHTONOS): They get bitter when others have a good life in some way. *Rom. 1:29, Matt. 27:18, Mark 15:10, Gal. 5:21, 1 Tim. 6:4, Titus 3:3, 1 Peter 2:1*

• QUARRELS, STRIFE (ERIS): A person who feels pleasure to have strife with people. *Rom. 1:29, Gal. 5:20, 1 Cor. 3:3, Rom. 1:11, 13:6-14 (13), Titus 3:9.*

• WHISPERERS (PSITHYRISTES): A person who talks badly about others behind their back. One of the first sins, the devil talked badly about God. Many people talk badly about Jesus also. *Rom 1:29, 2 Kor. 12:20, Psalm 41:7*

• SLANDERERS, BACKBITER (KATALALOS): A person who tries to put down others with strong bad words. *Rom. 1:30*

• HATERS OF GOD (THEOSTYGES): People who don't respect God and His will. *Romans 1:30.* Opposite: ONE WHO LOVES GOD (FILOTHEOS) 2 Tim. 3:4

• INSOLENT, SPITEFUL (HYBRISTES, HYBRIZO): People who find pleasure in hurting others. *Romans 1:30, Matt. 22:6, Luke 11:45, 18:32, 1 Tim.1:13, Acts 14:5, 1 Thess. 2:2*

• PROUD, ARROGANT (HYPEREPHANOS): A person who likes to be above others, and above God. Luke 1:51, Rom. 1:30, 2 Tim. 3:2, 1 Peter 5: 5-11, James 4:6

• **PROFANE, SECULARISED AND WORDLY (BEBELOS):** Have a foot in the world, more or less go for worldly things.

1 Tim. 1:9, 4:7, 6:20, 2 Tim. 2:16, Hebrew 12:16

• FATHERSLAYERS (PATRALOIAS): 1 Tim. 1:9
