As we said before, so say I now again, if any man preach any other gospel unto you than that you have received, let him be accursed. Says Paul, the Apostle, in Galatians 1:9

Jesus says:

I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live forever: and the bread that I will give is My flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, how can this Man give us His flesh to eat? Whosoever eats My flesh, and drinks My blood, has eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is meat indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. This with "law deeds affect" is not preached in a real way, and that's stopping us to go all the way with Jesus. This I can talk about for two days. But my friend don't be guilty, continue to do the good things you do, but seek the will of Jesus with a humble heart. Let us try to do what Jesus says. There are also sins that lead to Hell, all around and in us, if we are not alert. So let us have the mind of Jesus in His "first" preaching "Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the Kingdom of heaven." Matt. 5:3, always hungry for more righteousness that we need. With other words let us always pray

If we confess our sins He (God) is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. 1 Letter from John 1:9

"Come let us check up each other and talk out!" says the Lord. "If your sins are red as blood, they can be as white as snow. If they are red as scarlet, they can be like white wool." Isaiah 1:18 Come to Me (Jesus), all you that labour (are tired) and are heavy burdened and I (Jesus) will give you rest. Matt 11:28

Now I talk about pretty "strong" people, like leaders in churches that do wrong, or if we have had a good life as Christians for many years and still do bad, sinful, things, that are against the word of God.

BUT you can't judge weak Christian people, who have had a very bad background or really problem in life, if they do something bad, sinful. If we judge them, Jesus will judge us.

Jesus is really merciful to people who have had a bad life. But if we in the long run don't stop doing wrong, we get anger from Jesus. I hope you understand, please, talk with some good Christians about this. Jesus is really merciful if we confess our sins and try our best to get rid of our sins. Some sins are very heavy, then we need other people to help us in many ways.

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But the word is very near to you, in your mouth, and in your heart, that you may obey it. Deuteronomy 30:14

We can right now begin to change our life!

I call heaven and earth as witnesses this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both you and your seed may live. Deuteronomy 30:19 We choose - not God!

Dear people, I like to have a text all over the sky; "YOU CAN CHOOSE YOURSELF HOW YOU SHALL LIVE. AND DEAR FRIEND, PLEASE, CHOOSE JESUS AND THE WHOLE BIBLE." This is the big meaning with life – to independently choose the life with Jesus, when God is knocking

on our door, and He is knocking right now.

To be born again, to be saved, to be a Christian, is a quality decision to really make up in my mind "I will from now on follow Jesus and whatever He wants me to do and how to live. Read **John chapter 3.** And we Christians are to make decisions, if we want to follow everything that the Bible teaches us. I am totally sure that if we really follow the Bible and everything it teaches, people will be saved around us.

• "Freedom from condemnation the false way"

This is my personal name of this subject, when we Christians are false in our ways to live. This is a very common way to get people comforted with their sins. In all kind of churches, both charismatic and others. Charismatic's can talk about Jesus and the blood and the cross very, very much, and don't mention what kind of sins we must turn away from. So people can do the most horrible things in church, and also, so called, small sins without any conscience, even, so called, small sins destroy churches and people all over the world. This subject I can talk about for a week. Demon spirits are telling many Christian leaders Bible words after Bible words so both them and others get comfortable with their sins. In 1992 I throw away all Christian books and cassettes (very many) with this kind of teaching, and mostly everything was from charismatic Christians. Much was prosperity preaching, but also others have this preaching. After that I got peace and God began to do good wonders in my family and I began to read books by Charles Finney, Frank Mangs, David Wilkersson and other old Preachers. I also talked very much with my wife, how life is in function, together with Bible reading and praying.

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The Foundation law for revival:

And showing mercy to thousands of them that love Me (God the Father), and keep My commandments. Exodus 20:6

But how is the life in many churches? One person said to a worldly Christian "You are a Christian because then you can do whatever you want." this is really the problem with us Christians. We get into a "law deeds life" like the pharisees; we do right in 15 out of 20 good deeds, or 2 out of 20. Jesus takes my sins <u>whatever I do</u>, is also a saying among Christians. The most basic sinful thought in all history is maybe "I do this right then I can do that wrong." We can get so comfortable in groups of many people, that we are not fully seeking God's will in everything. Because the crowds of people do not think as Jesus thinks in everything, and then we follow them instead of Jesus (I talk about churches).

Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tenth of mint and anise and cumin, and have neglected the more important matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought you to have done, and not to leave the other undone. Matt. 23:23. It's very easy to be a hypocrite. We got to seek, all our lives, what Jesus and the Bible tells. Let us go with the "Jesus wind"

wherever it will blow. Read **Gospel of John 3**. 5
