On page 4 and 5 was Isaiah 52, now comes 53; the whole chapter of the suffering Messiah. He for sure suffered for our sins, so that we can have a good conscience and be a people with holy love (as in Sweden in the old times).

Isaiah 53:1-15

Who has believed our report? And to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed? For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He has no form and not attractive; and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering and we hid as it were our faces from Him; He was despised, and we respect Him not. Surely He has borne our suffering, and carried our sorrows: yet we did respect Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions; He was wounded for our sinfulness: the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the sinfulness of us all. He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth: He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so He opened not his mouth. Abraham was willing to sacrifice His son Isaac, whom he truly loved. God the Father sacrificed His Son, Jesus Christ, whom He truly loved;

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 3:16

Jesus is the best "Christmas gift" ever, given by God to us humans. God the Father told His servant – the Prophet Isaiah - what was going to happen in the future. The Prophet Isaiah lived about 700 years BC (before Christ). Isaiah's book in the Bible is full of prophetic words about Jesus. What a gift; the most sinful man can be forgiven and saved, because Jesus was sacrificed on the cross for everyone in the whole world, to give us eternal life when we leave this world. The only thing we have to do is to have faith and repent from sins. You may feel your sins are too hard to get rid of, but you must know that Jesus will help you on your way, if you are honest to Him. He forgives you over and over again if you fail. But in the long run you will grow as a Christian and the hard sins will pass away, because you don't long for them anymore. This is how the Christian life works. Remember that Jesus is full of love and He will help you to be as clean as possible from sins. When you walk with Him, you will be able to help others to be saved. Read the whole Bible and try to do your best. Many times we need help from other people.

The basic Christmas prophesy about Jesus in Sweden for about 1000 years;

Isaiah 1:18-20 (the worst sinner can be clean).

Come now, and let us reason together, says the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet (red color), they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like karmosin (red color), and they shall be as wool. If you be willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land: But if you refuse and rebel, you shall be consumed with the sword: for the mouth of the Lord has spoken it.

Isaiah 52:1-15 (God the Father prepares Israel to welcome His Son).

Awake, awake; put on your strength, O Zion; put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the Holy City: for from now on there shall no more come into you, the uncircumcised and the unclean. Shake yourself from the dust; arise, and sit down (enthroned), O Jerusalem: loose yourself from the bands of your neck, O captive daughter of Zion. For this says the Lord, You have sold yourselves for nothing; and you shall be redeemed without money. For this says the Lord God, My people went down before into Egypt to stay there; and the Assyrian oppressed them without cause. Now therefore, what have I here, says the Lord, that My people is taken away for nothing? They that rule over them make them to howl (cry, weep), says the Lord; and My name continually every day is blasphemed. Therefore My people shall know My

shall declare His generation? For He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of My people was He stricken. And He made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither was any lying in His mouth.

Yet it pleased the Lord to hurt Him; He has put Him to suffering: when You shall make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand. He shall see of the hard work of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for He shall bear their sins. Therefore will I divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because He has poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the transgressors; and He bare the sin of many, and made intercession (offer up prayers) for the transgressors. **Isaiah 53:1-12**

Other good words from Isaiah that will happen in the future; **Isaiah 2:10-11**- Enter into the rock, and hide you in the dust, for fear of the Lord, and for the glory of His Majesty. The noble looks of man shall be humbled, and the pride of men shall be bowed down, and the Lord alone shall be high-ranking in that day. **Isaiah 2:22** - Stop trusting people, who has just a breath in his nostrils, how small is not people? Who is the Lord in these Bible verses? For sure not a Christian leader! Read also Colossians chapter 1! **7**

name: therefore they shall know in that day that I am He that does speak: behold, it is I. How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of Him (Jesus) that brings good information, that produce peace; that brings good news of good, that publish (put out) salvation; that says unto Zion; your God reigns. Your watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the Lord shall bring again Zion. Break forth into joy; sing together, you empty places of Jerusalem: for the Lord has comforted His people, He has redeemed Jerusalem. The Lord has made exposed His holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God. Depart you, depart you, go you out from there! Touch no unclean thing; go you out of the midst of her; be you clean that bear the vessels of the Lord. For you shall not go out with quickness, nor go by escape: for the Lord will go before you; and the God of Israel will be your rear guard. Behold, My servant shall act wisely, He shall be exalted and praised, and be very high. As many were shocked at Him; His appearance was so disfigured more than any man, and His form more than the sons of men: So shall He amaze many nations; the kings shall shut their mouths at Him: for that which had not been told them shall they see; and that which they had not heard shall they consider. **Isaiah 52:1-15**
